ITINERARY

Day 1: October 20, 2017 – U.S: Depart from SFO for your flight to Buenos Aires, Argentina.

Day 2: October 21, 2017 - BUENOS AIRES

Arrive in Buenos Aires. Please proceed to baggage claim and clear customs before meeting your tour manager who will be escorting you to your centrally located hotel, NH 9 De Julio or similar. Overnight at your hotel in Buenos Aires.

Day 3: October 22, 2017 - BUENOS AIRES - Highlights: Recoleta - Palermo - Plaza de Mayo - Puerto Madero - San Telmo - La Boca - Teatro Colon – Evita Museum

Breakfast at hotel. Today, enjoy a Buenos Aires city tour, Argentina's capital city, also known as the "Paris of South America". First, visit the glamorous neighborhoods of Recoleta and its most famous cemetery, Palermo, followed by May Square and the Pink House (Casa Rosada), the Metropolitan Cathedral, the newest & trendiest Puerto Madero area and many other emblematic buildings and palaces of unique architectural, historical, and cultural value. The visit would not be complete without the sights of the first settlements of the city of Buenos Aires. See the picturesque neighborhood of San Telmo, residence to the porteño aristocracy until the end of the XIX century and where the renowned antiques market is held every Sunday; Caminito Street, in the colorful, Italian immigrants neighborhood of La Boca. Continue to the Teatro Colón (Colón Theatre) in Buenos Aires, one of the most important opera houses in the world. Its rich and prestigious history and its exceptional acoustics and architectural features rank it among some of the world best theatres. Finally, visit the Evita Museum: Learn about Evita's life and work via modern "museography" techniques that uses state of the art technology to bring history closer to the present. Tonight, enjoy dinner in a local Argentinian Steakhouse. (B, D)

Day 4: October 23, 2017 - BUENOS AIRES - Highlights: San Isidro Cathedral - Tigre Navigation - Gato Blanco Restaurant

Breakfast at hotel. Today, depart on a day tour of the Tigre Delta navigation. Located only 30 km north of Buenos Aires, the City of Tigre is the access to the exotic delta of the Paraná River, a huge stretch of subtropical forest including thousands of islets. This delta is unique in the world as it merges into another river instead of flowing into the sea. After traveling along the Rio de la Plata, we arrive to San Isidro to make a small stop to visit the Neo-Gothic Cathedral built in the XIX century. From here, we continue to Tigre Pier to board on one of the typical regional boats that will take us on a spectacular ride around the islands, enjoying nature and amazing sights all around. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant located on one of the islands. (B, L)

Day 5: October 24, 2017 - BUENOS AIRES – Day at leisure or Optional tour "Parrilla and Tango Lesson"

Breakfast at hotel. Today is a day to enjoy the incredible city of Buenos Aires on your own, or join an optional full day tour. Parrillas are Argentine steakhouses offering the most traditional Buenos Aires cuisine. Most visitors to the city only dine at the most touristy parrillas published in guidebooks and sadly miss out on some of the city's most delicious gems. To experience and taste authentic Porteño flavors, join us on our culinary tour of the city, to discover local hole-in-the wall restaurants, enjoying traditional parrilla foods in each and enjoy excellent Argentine wine, learn about Argentina's culture and cuisine, visit one of the best artisanal "heladerias" (ice cream shops) in the city and meet others during the relaxed and social tour. Later, you will feel, and enjoy the authentic Tango Argentino, while accomplished and well-known Argentine Tango dancers will introduce you to the fine art of Tango. Tango lesson and dancing. (B)

Day 6: October 25, 2017 - BUENOS AIRES - Highlights: Santa Susana Ranch - Traditional Argentine Asado - Gauchos Entertainment - Folkloric Show.

Breakfast at hotel. Get ready to spend a day in the Pampas. Home to the gaucho, the humid pampa is one of the most fertile natural prairies in the world and is famous for its production of beef and cereals. Only a few kilometers away from the City of Buenos Aires, in a natural environment with beautiful landscapes, we will be hosted for lunch and greeted with the typical national asado, empanadas, and excellent Argentinian wines. The wild smell of the countryside will invite us to discover a charming hundred-year-old rural tradition in the midst of the XXI century. Experience folk songs and dances, equestrian activities, and an incredible show of traditional gaucho skills, such as ring races, cuadreras (horse races), entrevero de tropillas (horse games). Overnight at your hotel in Buenos (B, L)

Day 7: October 26, 2017 - BUENOS AIRES – Day at leisure..

Breakfast at hotel. Enjoy a day at leisure in beautiful Buenos Aires. Don't forget to ask your local host with additional suggestions on places to see, Shopping, etc....Later in the evening, you will experience a Dinner & tango show at the "Café de los Angelitos". With over a 100 years of history in Buenos Aires and at the forefront of today's "Tango", this local Dance Hall combines the most exquisite plates of an international kitchen, typical orchestra and tango show carried out by professional artists. Day 1 - October 17, 2017: US - CHILE: Depart from San Francisco (SFO) for your flight to Santiago.

Day 2 – October 18, 2017: Arrive in Santiago. Please proceed to baggage claim and clear customs before meeting your tour manager who will be escorting you to the hotel Galerías in Downtown Santiago. Today, your tour begins with a visit of “Bernardo O’Higgins Avenue”, better known as “Alameda”, which is the main city strip. Visit the San Francisco Church, located in the heart of Santiago, followed by the bohemian and gourmet district of Bellavista with new hip restaurants, boutiques, and avant-garde galleries occupying loft spaces and lordly mansions that punctuate tree-lined streets awash with colorful antique homes. See San Cristobal Hill and enjoy its panoramic views of the city with the statue of the “Virgen de la Inmaculada Concepcion”. Visit “Forestal Park”, then make your way to the heart of the city to the “Plaza de Armas”, and see the Cathedral, the City Council, the Central Post Office and the National Historical Museum. Continue to the Presidential Palace “La Moneda” and finally visit the famous “Santiago Central Market” and its picturesque Seafood Stores. Enjoy lunch at “El Galeon”, a restaurant specializing in Chilean cuisine. Overnight at the Hotel Galerías. (B)

Day 3 – October 19, 2017: HALF DAY CONCHA Y TORO VINERY WITH LUNCH: depart from Santiago and make your way towards the mountain valley of Pirque, to reach the “Concha y Toro Vinery”. Founded in 1883 by Melchor Concha y Toro, this winery is now the largest exporter in Latin America. Operating in more than 130 countries, it is one of the most important brands in the world of wine. The winery has achieved international recognition primarily by their brands, “Casillero del Diablo” and “Don Melchor”. Enjoy a guided visit of the facilities and taste some of the best wines. After the visit, enjoy a delicious lunch of Chilean food in the restaurant located in the same locality of Pirque. Return to Hotel Galerías and overnight. (B, L)

Day 4 – October 20, 2017: FULL DAY TOUR VIÑA DEL MAR & VALPARAISO: Enjoy the day at leisure or Depart from Santiago to the coastline, passing through the fertile “Curacaví and Casablanca Valleys”, covered with vineyards, fruit plantations and forest reserves. En route, you will visit two important cities: “Viña del Mar”, the main resort of Chile and “Valparaíso”, a port city founded in the XVI century and declared “World heritage by UNESCO”. The promenade includes a panoramic tour by the emblematic places of Valparaíso, such as “National Congress”, “O’Higgins Park”, “Italia Park”, “Victoria Square”, “Sotomayor Square” and “Prat” dock located in the same port. You will then visit the Museum of the famous Chilean poet and writer and Nobel prize-winning in Literature (1971), Pablo Neruda named “Casa Museo La Sebastiana”. Within the house, marvel at collections of old and navy maps and multiple paintings. Then walk to the wonderful viewpoints of “Atkinson” and “Gervasoni”, located in the most important hills of Valparaíso, “Cerro Alegre” and “Cerro Concepción”. Ride the picturesque cable cars, which are to this day, still connecting the city. Enjoy a delicious lunch on your own at a local restaurant in the area. Continue to the city of Viña del Mar, also known as the “Garden City”. Walk past the picturesque “Flower Clock” and go through “Peru Avenue” with its traditional “Casino” and fine “Hotel Del Mar”. Finally, take a picture of an authentic Moai from the Easter Island located on the outside of the “Museum of Paleontology and Anthropology Fonck”. Return to the Hotel.. Farewell dinner at hotel Galerías.(B).

Day 5 – October 21, 2017: SANTIAGO-BUENOS AIRES: After Breakfast, transfer from your hotel to Santiago Airport for your flight to Buenos Aires and start your regular tour program, (B).

2 nights Optional Iguazu Post Tour – Extension \$995 / per person in double occupancy - \$195 / single room supplement

Day 8: October 27, 2017: BUENOS AIRES TO IGUAZU

Arrive in Iguazu. Please proceed to baggage claim and clear customs before meeting your tour manager who will be escorting you to your hotel. Dinner this evening will be in Iguazu with the group. Overnight at hotel Mercure in Iguazu. (D)

Day 9: October 28, 2017: IGUAZU - Argentinean Falls Tour. Breakfast at hotel. Iguazú National Park a total of over 135,000 acres— bears the name of the river serving as northern border, which means “great waters” in the guaraní language. Surrounded by a lush subtropical rainforest, you will discover the majestic Iguazú Waterfalls. The water volume of the Iguazu Falls is equivalent to a combined 275 falls, which places it among the most important and spectacular waterfalls in the world. On different footbridges, we will visit the heart of the waterfalls, appreciating them from different angles. We will visit the lower pathways, and feel part of nature, refreshing ourselves with waterfall drizzle. On the upper paths, we will stop at different viewpoints, and then reach the grand balcony at Garganta del Diablo (Devil’s Throat) where water falls down from 80 meters. Enjoy lunch at El Fortin restaurant. Return to the hotel and overnight. (B, L)

Bonus inclusion: Adventure Navigation Tour (Argentinean side)

With powerful boats, we shall bounce into the Lower Iguazu River Canyon and bordering the San Martín Island to reach the “Tres Mosqueteros” Fall. At this point we will see the falls from both the Argentinian and Brazilian sides as well as the Garganta del Diablo. Finalizing this trip, experience the unforgettable baptism shower at the bottom of the San Martín waterfall, the tallest cascade that any boat may endeavor. This excursion starts and concludes at the dock located in front of the San Martín Island. NOTE: Difficult walk: 100 meter staircase. Trip restricted to children under 12 years old, pregnant women, people with osteoporosis, neck, back conditions or surgery and any person with any physical, cognitive and/or sensorial disability unable to react in a nautical emergency. Overnight at hotel Mercure in Iguazu.

Day 10: October 29, 2017: IGUAZU Guarani community visit / BUENOS AIRES. Breakfast at hotel. It is a unique opportunity to make contact with the local people and with their ancestral culture, the “guaranties” open the doors of their community to divulge the secrets of the forest, their natural medicine, their culture, songs, dances, crafts, philosophy of life and beliefs. The tour begins with a “native guide” who will lead you on footpaths deep in the forest towards the village. During the route the native will explain his beliefs, myths and legends. Then, marvel at the colony’s crafts that they build using resources such as wood, lianas, seeds etc. Free time for lunch followed by a transfer back to the airport for your flight back to Buenos Aires, connecting with the USA and SFO. (B)

Pricing: Tour price is \$3,395 per person in double occupancy and based on 35 passengers traveling together. For single occupancy add \$475. Fuel surcharges are included at \$516 per person and air taxes are included at \$133 per person. Fuel surcharges and air taxes are valid at the time of printing but are subject to change.
